

Holmbridge Scarecrow Festival 2021



Welcome to the SECOND St.Davids Scarecrow Festival in Holmbridge and Hinchliffe Mill. We launched the first festival last year as we sadly had to cancel the famous St.Davids Bonfire. Our Bonfire serves 2 purposes; firstly it brings people together, brings happiness and joy to so many and brings the community together. Secondly, it also raises lots of money to support community work across the valley and beyond. As we had to cancel the Bonfire, we wanted to do something else that would be safe, allow for Social Distancing but that would also help meet those two aims. As a result, we launched the very first St.Davids Scarecrow Festival.

As it was so popular, we have been asked (and asked and asked) to do another one, so we are DELIGHTED to be able to be holding the second Scarecrow Festival on the 17th to the 20th June. Hopefully we will have nice weather and we will have lots more daylight than in November so we hope that even more people will be able to enjoy this years event.

We have detailed in this map all of the places that you will find Scarecrows during the week. There may even be a few more pop up that weren't planned, so do look out for them too! This years' theme is CELEBRITY (although one or two will just be normal scarecrows)

How it Works?

The Scarecrows have all been made by individuals around our community. The Scarecrows will be found from Holmbridge to Hinchliffe Mill to the Holmfirth border all the way up to Holme Village. Some are further back into Holmbridge and Hinchliffe Mill than on the main road, so the route is broken up into a number of different maps to help make it clearer where to

go. Each map displays numbers that then correlate to a grid on the following page with the list of houses that are displaying Scarecrows on that street.

The route does not need to be completed all in one go. With the route being open for most of the week, take the time to see all of the Scarecrows at your own pace.

Do I Need to Pay?

The map is free. We know that times are hard for lots of people at the moment and if you are struggling, please take the map, enjoy the walk and the Scarecrows. It really is important that this route serves the purpose of bringing happiness to people and our community together.

If you are able to donate, that would really make a massive difference within the Community. The money raised from the Scarecrow Festival is going to **St.Davids Church** to support the work of Church in the community, to **Hinchliffe Mill Junior and Infant School** and **Holmbridge Pre-School**. 



